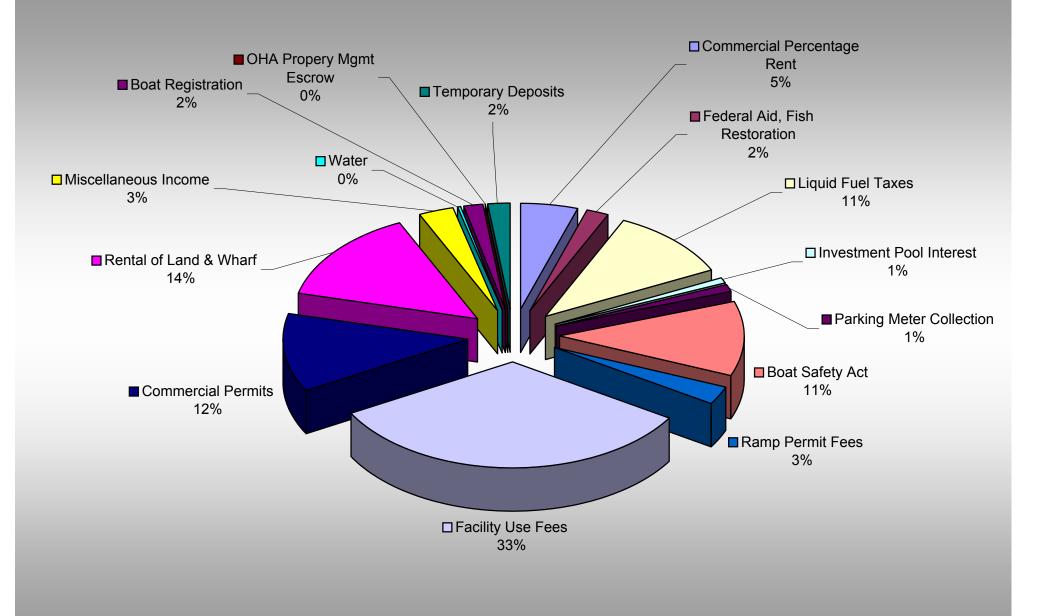


Terms	
Commercial Percentage Rent	Represents amounts paid by commercial operators for their slip fees and their percentage rent. It excludes amounts for security deposits.
Facility Use Fees	Represents slip fees paid for by recreational boaters for their slip fees and related service. It excludes amounts for security deposits.
Budget and Finance Assessment	Represents amount paid to the Department of Budget and Finance for services performed and is set by the Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS). It is allocated to the cost centers based on the number of permits at the cost center to the total.
Office of Hawaiian Affairs	Represents the amounts paid for the use of ceded lands. Amounts shown represent an allocation based on the number of permits at the cost center to the total. In FY 2004 DOBOR began recording the OHA assessment at the appropriate cost center.
	DOBOR does not make payments to OHA for Ala Wai, Wailoa, Keauhou, Port Allen, Mauanalua Bay, Sand Island Ramp, Oahu South Shore ORMA's, Hanalei Bay, Wailua River, Waikaea Canal, and Kealakekua Bay.
District Overhead Allocation	Represents the income and expenses of the district office allocated to each location in the district. The allocation was based on the number of accounts in each cost center.
Statewide Overhead Allocation	Represents the income & expenses of the statewide administration offices allocated to each district base on the number of boats registered in the district, then allocated to each cost center location as described above.
Miscellaneous Income	Amount reflects interest earned on Boating Special Revenue and Recreational Boating Safety Act funds. It also reflects amount paid for temporary mooring permits.
Ramp Permit Fees	This reflects amounts paid for a ramp permit that allows the user to use any ramp in the state to launch their vessel for recreational use only
Boat Registration	All vessels in the State of Hawaii are required to registered have a federal or state registration. This amount reflects amounts paid for state registration.

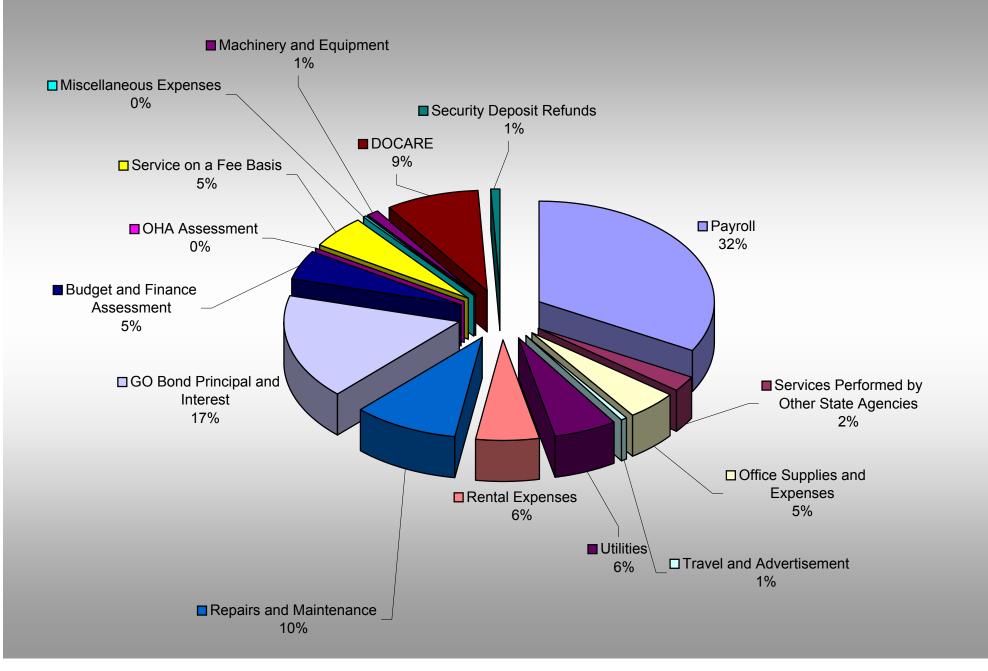
